Many nursing homes are suffering from staff shortages, recruitment worries and, most recently, the strain of the pandemic, which have led to an increased workload that calls for new solutions. The current generation of our Elvido care bed series strives with every detail to relieve the burden on caregivers and to improve the quality of life for residents. The focus is on digital assistance systems such as the Out-of-Bed systems and a modular design that transforms each individual bed into a customised bed of choice.

The Elvido product family comprises the vervo as an allround product, the forto being a heavy-duty variant, the all mechanical adjustable rega and the easy to manoeuvre movo. Models that can be used in any ward, including psychiatric wards even, with the most stringent requirements.

Elvido movo

- Height adjustment: approx. 28 – 83 cm
- Manoeuvrability:
- Large 100-mm double castors easy to manoeuvre even in tight spaces and when transporting over longer distances
- Overcomes smaller obstacles such as door thresholds effortlessly
- Central locking castors unlock or lock the position with a single operation
- A directional castor facilitates steering

Well-being without the use of restraints



Good health and long-term independence of the residents contribute decisively to the well-being and relief of everyone in the nursing home. The Elvido range of low-height beds promotes protection, mobilisation and comfort, without restricting freedom. Over the past decade, many nursing homes have worked to reduce the use of restraints by more than 50%.

Our Elvido is built with this goal in mind, with its many supportive adjustment options and intelligent split safety sides.

Positions and side elements

Easy Click – easy handling and excellent hygiene

Full-length and combinable safety sides can be removed and attached without tools

Residents at high risk of falls need maximum protection - the classic full-length safety side is often the preferred choice in this case. If desired, it can be used together with the combinable split safety side on the opposite side, to achieve an ideal balance of safety and freedom. The centre post of the combinable safety sides also serves as a robust mobilisation aid.

The Elvido series comes with the intelligent Easy Click system as standard for both safety sides. The safety side bars can be "clicked" onto pre-assembled brackets and removed without the use of tools. This makes it easy to assemble and clean the bed. The elegant plastic caps protect the inside of the bars from dirt and liquids. Also, the Easy Click system makes it possible to switch the safety sides from one bed to another, for economic efficiency.

Easy Click allows safety side bars to be attached to pre-assembled brackets and removed without tools.





The bars can be lowered with an easy-to-operate release mechanism on the headboard and footboard.

▲ To lower the bars of the combinable safety side, simply press the button on the centre post. When not required, the post itself can simply be removed and stored in a holder under the bed.




Vario Safe – the system to meet changing requirements Modular design opens up new possibilities in everyday use

Attaching and removing the headboard and footboard on all Elvido models is completely tool-free thanks to our patented Vario Safe system. This is a great advantage when it comes to care routines that have to be carried out in bed. It also enables to fit new head- and footboards at a later stage to restyle the look of the bed.

As an alternative to the full-length or combinable safety side, the Vario Safe system offers the option of a split safety side. Each safety side element can be raised in two stages or set diagonal and provides tailor-made safety. If protection is not required along the entire bed, a safety side at the head end, can be combined with side panels at the foot end. All these elements can be removed and replaced without the use of tools. The picture below illustrates the many options it offers.

Replace or remove footboards as you wish

- A removable footboard allows better access to the resident, e.g. for foot care
- or low footboards for improved visual orientation



Attach or remove the split safety side as required

- Two elements with lengths of 90 cm and 110 cm can be freely combined or used separately
- Use of the 110-cm element at the head end provides standard-compliant protection
- · Use of the 90-cm element at the head end provides reassurance and orientation and leaves ample space to get in and out of bed
- · If the integrated bed extension is used, two 110-cm elements can be attached

Ergonomics and mobilisation

Relieving the strain on caregivers every day

Back pain is one of the biggest problems in the care profession – as many as two thirds of caregiver suffer from it, according to surveys. This makes it even more important to be able to work in an upright position in many situations, in a way that is easy on the back. The maximum height of the Elvido beds of up to 85 cm is a great help here, as are the modular, removable elements that allow easy access to the resident. The bed is also designed with many mobilisation aids that make it easier for residents to get up without assistance.



ESSENTIALLY BETTER **Efficient prevention** of back problems

- Very large height adjustment range, from approx. 25 to 85 cm depending on the model variant
- Easy access to residents
- Independent mobilisation of the resident means less strain on carers

Positioning options

Supporting recovery and promoting independence

The comfortable adjustment options offered by the Elvido series promote residents' long-term health and support caregivers in their work. The flexibly adjustable mattress base allows to set it to a reverse-Trendelenburg position to help prevent aspiration and pneumonia. The cardiac chair position is used to relieve the heart and to facilitate breathing. The Trendelenburg position and the extended leg raise can be used to treat shock and relieve the veins.



Positioning



Bed height settings

▲ Low position of around 25 cm prevents fall injuries.



▲ By adjusting the mattress base to suit the individual, residents can get up much more easily on their own. The memory function of the intermediate stop can be set to suit each person. The factory setting is at 38 cm.



▲ The cardiac chair position reduces strain on the heart and strengthens the circulation.



▲ The corpus of the bed can swivel to allow the feet to be lowered to the reverse-Trendelenburg position, e.g. to facilitate swallowing and prevent aspiration.




▲ Depending on the model variant, the highest position is between 80 and 85 cm, - i.e. at hip height and therefore ideal for back-friendly work.

The Elvido offers many position, i.e. those to ease breathing and improve the supply of oxygen.



▲ The Trendelenburg position can reduce the effects of shock.



▲ Adjusting the lower leg rest to about 22° relieves pressure and alleviates pain.

Bed extension

Tall residents need more space. The integrated 20 cm extension of the bed frame ensures optimum comfort and makes our Elvido beds particularly future-proof.

If the Elvido is to be used with safety sides at the head end only, or without any safety sides at all, only a longer mattress is required to use the extension and no further retrofitting is required.

Of course, the extended bed looks cosier and is safer with safety sides and panels of the right length. Depending on the modular system, many customisation options are available. The lower leg rest can also be extended, if desired.

For beds with the Vario Safe system, the 90 cm-long side elements can be replaced tool-free with 110 cm-long elements to adapt to the bed extension.





Out-of-Bed smart

The optional Out-of-Bed system supports the work of caregivers, particularly at night. It reports, for example, if a resident hasn't returned to bed within a selected time after a visit to the toilet.

Flexible operating concept

Handset to accomodate requirements

The Elvido is operated using one of a selection of handsets. Simple, self-explanatory operation of the bed with the handset is helpful in more than one way. Caregivers need to keep track and maintain control even in tense situations. Even with limited abilities, residents should be able to make simple adjustments themselves in order to enjoy greater comfort and take the burden off caregivers.

The choise is yours

To satisfy different preferences, there is a choice between the standard illuminated handset HB400 or the optional LCD handset with an illuminated display and 3 buttons.

HB400

The buttons on the HB400 are clearly identifiable, day and night, with a transparent black border during the day, and pleasant lighting at night. The Trendelenburg function is integrated and does not require an additional handset. All options for the resident can be locked selectively.

LCD handset

The optional LCD handset shows the adjustment functions on a large illuminated display. The arrow keys make it easy to select and activate the desired option. Caregivers can temporarily open all locked functions and adjust the bed as required.


Out-of-Bed handset

If an Out-of-Bed smart system was chosen, the bed will be equipped with an additional handset. The Out-of-Bed handset is used to activate the system and to set the alert time as well as additional functions such as the automatic light system.











▲ The lighted buttons are easy to see, even at night.

 All adjustment functions can be individually unlocked with the aid of a magnet in the mattress retainer bar.

Lamps Protection and quality of life

Our lamps provide pleasant, cosy lighting for the residents without disturbing other people in the room. They generate very little heat, which makes them especially safe.

The Sola, Stella and Sira models have an attractive and elegant design. They can be mounted in the patient lifting pole sleeves, on the bed, or on a receiver in at the bedside cabinet.




▲ With the Sola model, there is a choice of operating it with a switch on the head of the lamp or with a cable switch.

lamps additionally support the automatic light system in combination with the Out-of-Bed smart.

- A variety of designs are available, whether stylish and streamlined, or with a coloured accent on the lampshade and LED bulb.
- All models can be connected with a 3.5-mm jack plug and suitable adapter cables, either directly via the bed or to a socket using a power supply unit.
- The Stella and Sira models can be integrated into the automated lighting function of Out-of-Bed smart.
- The Stella can be operated manually with a switch on the head of the lamp, and the Sira with a cable switch. With the Sola model, either of the two options can be chosen.



Maintenance friendly through cost-saving 24-volt system

A high level of safety, optimised costs and minimal effort of operation: the optional 24-volt drive system is an attractive option for all powered Elvido beds.


The voltage is converted to 24 volts directly at the power socket. Therefore, no components carrying 230 volts are anywhere in the vicinity of the resident, which means that residents enjoy a higher level of safety.

Costs and effort are saved due to the significant reduction in regular leakage current tests. For a 24-volt drive system, these are only necessary once every 10 years instead of every year.



A mains transformer unit produces a safety extra-low voltage directly at the power socket. The optional wall spacer on the bed protects sockets, walls and furniture.

Tests for leakage current only once every 10 years



Optional chassis covers

The Elvido vervo variant is already equipped with four plastic covers on the corners of the chassis as standard. They encase some of the technical features, and their silver-grey colour matches the tone of the frame. A more complete covering is available on request. Its two plastic elements cover the entire front faces of the chassis and can be supplied in several homelike wood decors. This gives the bed its own special look.


