Upholstered headboards

In line with individual wishes, upholstered elements can also be used selectively – such as on the headboard only. Care beds with Vario Safe offer a wide selection of hard-wearing upholstery options.



Something to hold on

Select head- and footboards fitting the purpose. Residents with balance issues and poor gait will benefit greatly from footboards with bars, so they have something to hold on when insecure.





Provide orientation without restriction

Diagonally raised safety sides can be a helpful aid to orientation, particularly in the case of residents with dementia, without restricting their movement or arousing negative associations.

This aids in implementing the recommendations of the 'Global Guidelines for Falls in Older Adults,' as Vario Safe elements enhance safe and supported transfers, encourage self-mobilization, and reduce anxiety.

Residents can easily reach the bedside cabinet, for example, if they wish to switch on the bedside light or grab their glasses.



Extension

Vario Safe enables the bed to be extended without the need for tools, featuring a patented quick-release mechanisms and eliminating the need for hand screws.

Whether integrated – in the case of Elvido and Tereno – or slide-in in the case of the Vario Safe system on the Libra: the ability to extend the mattress base to 210 or 220 cm allows you to provide even tall residents with a suitable bed.



Elvido also offers the option of extending the adjustable lower leg rest.

Ideal for independent mobilisation

A 90 cm-long Vario Safe element at the head end is used to support safe independent mobilisation. It assists with getting in and out of bed and also provides support and orientation. This helps to maintain residents' mobility for as long as possible.





Lengths and positions at your fingertips to suit requirements

Caregivers can adapt the Vario Safe elements individually to meet specific requirements, whether for a new resident or a resident's mobility has changed.

Intuitive one-hand operation

The safety sides can be raised with one hand in any position without needing to unlock them.



For hygienic cleaning

Thorough cleaning of Vario Safe safety sides is very easy since they are not concealed behind panels. They can stay on the bed for cleaning, but if needed, they can be easily removed without any tools.



Easy access

Vario Safe is designed for tool-free and screwless removal of headboards and footboards to allow physiotherapy to take place in bed or to enable more extensive care routines.



Sophisticated safety

Variable and safe: the system prevents accidental lowering of the split safety sides when pressure is applied, as their own weight ensures they remain securely locked. To lower them, the load on the unlocking mechanism must first be slightly reduced.





Tailor-made comfort for the resident and a harmonious, feel-good living environment

- Comfortable and securely supported, residents benefit from personalized adjustments that cater to their changing mobility and individual preferences.
- In combination with high-quality upholstery or exclusively in warm wood decors: residents feel at home in a pleasing and cosy ambience.
- Footboards with a handrail offer residents a secure grip to steady themselves when needed.

- Short side elements on the entry/exit side of the bed ensure that residents always transfer at the ideal place for greater safety and independence.
- Practical details are integrated: if a call button is installed temporarily, it can be routed through the handset holder to keep it easily and conveniently within the resident's reach.



Fabrics and quilting

A range of attractive fabrics and faux leathers are available for the Nobla headboard/footboard and the Vario Safe system side panels. Headboards and footboards are available with plain upholstery or attractive quilting.



Vertical lines

Within practical reach

In just a few easy steps, beds can be made up to 13 cm narrower and 7 cm shorter for manoeuvring in confined spaces.




